With an annual attendance of over 3,000 there is no way to meet to the current guidelines and ensure that we are providing a safe and healthy environment for our citizens.

Pending changes to the NM Public Health order, the City of Alamogordo & Trisha Roberts Agency, plan to host a Halloween Drive-In Movie on Friday, October 30th at Square 47, with Medlin Ramps, at the intersect of Highways 54 & 70. The City is also planning a Drive-Thru Trick or Treat on the morning of Saturday, October 31st from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm, also at Square 47. Trick-or-Treaters will remain in their car for the duration of the event and all organizations handing out candy will be following Covid Safe Practices.
